



# **Admission Policy for Bridgeview**

# **Bridgeview Admissions Policy**

**Bridgeview is a setting for children with social, emotional and behavioural difficulties. Engaging, protecting and teaching 'our children' must be the starting point for all policies. This policy must be read in conjunction with our Safeguarding policy.**

## **Introduction**

Bridgeview is a primary day school for pupils with an Education Health Care Plan (EHCP).

Pupils from Hull and surrounding areas with an EHCP are admitted following consultation with the school by the Special Educational Needs (SEN) team. If it is identified that the school can meet the child's social, emotional and behavioural difficulties an admission meeting is arranged.

If the EHCP identifies the need for one to one support in the classroom, the referring authority would be asked to meet the additional cost.

The EHCP is reviewed annually allowing professionals, parents/carers and the child the opportunity to discuss if the current placement is fulfilling the child's needs and also plan for the next 12 months, both educationally and personally. This review would consider whether the child should remain in Bridgeview or seek an alternative provision, either in a special or mainstream setting.

## **Monitoring and review**

This policy will be monitored by the Local Governing Board.

The policy will be reviewed every two years, or earlier in the light of any change in circumstances or legislation.
